This is the 4th annual Leadership Seminar at the Belize City Church of Christ. Jeffrey Howell and Gary Cosby are in Belize this week. Today we are worshipping with the Belize City Church of Christ. Jeffrey will be preaching Sunday and will be conducting the seminar Monday through Thursday.

We invite all the Ministers and leaders from the Churches of Christ throughout the whole country of Belize to come to Belize City and attend the seminar. This gives them a chance to fellowship together and get to know the church leaders from all over Belize.

Topics include how to conduct Bible studies, unity in the church, qualifications for Elders, how to develop sermons and all topics for leadership in the church. There are many questions ask and answered, as well as discussions on the leadership of the church.

We got the idea for the seminar after the 2018 campaign to Belize City, when the leaders asked for more help and training on developing sermons and study in general. Richard Harp used his time to teach the leaders and men from the congregation that week and they all thanked us for this part of the campaign that year.

Covid hit and it would be 2022 when the first Leadership Seminar was held at the Belize City Church of Christ. This was our first seminar, so we had a learning curve on finding all the Churches of Christ in Belize and contacting the ministers and leaders to invite them and get hotel rooms and food for those from out of town. There were 16 that attended the seminar. It was a great success, and the reviews were very positive. We were able to get contact information from those that attended and asked them to let others know about the seminar, and we planned on it being an annual event.

The 2nd year 2023 we were able to contact more Churches and there were 40 in attendance.

The 3rd year 2024 we were able to contact even more Churches and there were 35 in attendance. There were several not able to attend due to having to work and not being able to get off and there were health conditions that caused some to not attend.

This year we have been in contact with many throughout the country. Again, this year there are some that are having health conditions and sickness that will cause them to not be able to attend. One from last year that had a stroke a few days before the seminar will be attending this year after a remarkable recovery.

Please pray for the Ministers and Leaders of the Church there in Belize that they will continue to be strong in teaching God's word. Pray for the ones this year that are not going to be attending and the families and members of the Churches of Christ. Thank you for your Mission Sunday contribution that makes this mission to Belize possible.

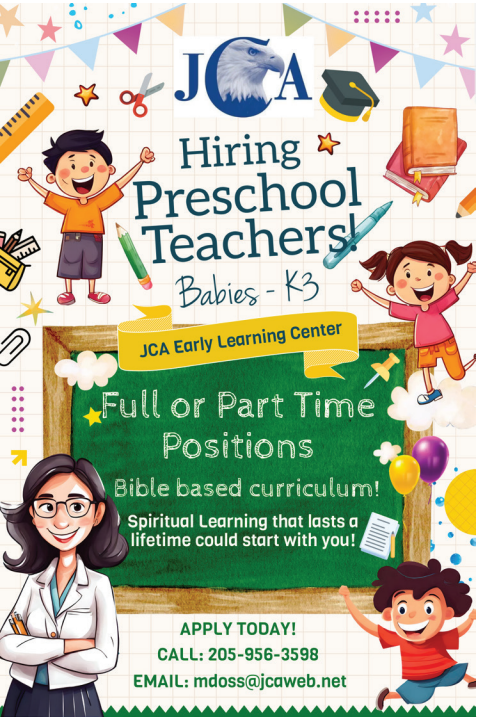
