BELIZE LEADERSHIP SEMINAR 2025 REPORT

Our mission to the country of Belize started in 1969, from baptizing one person and establishing the Belize City Church. From that congregation over the years there are Churches of Christ throughout the whole country. There have been campaigns over the years in Belize City, Corozal, Burrell Boom, Dangriga, Independence, Punta Gorda, Belmopan, Ladyville, San Ignacio and Hattieville.

The men in the Church asked for more teaching on the Bible and leadership in the Church. We started the 'Belize Leadership Seminar' four years ago. Belize City is centered in the middle of the country and enables the ministers and leaders from the Churches throughout the country to meet for a week of Bible lessons and questions.

Bro. Jeffrey prepares and presents the lessons Monday through Thursday. The men attending the seminar each year are from Corozal in the north to Punta Gorda in the south.

This year the attendance was between 20 to 32 each session. Jeffrey presents the lesson and then there is a question and answer period.

This year there were two baptisms during the Seminar. Jody Read, from North Carolina, a missionary in Belize working mainly in the southern area had been having a study with a gentleman from San Antonio in the south, that works in Belize City. Bro. Jody invited him to the hotel after work to continue studying and he was baptized.

Sunday, when we arrived at the Belize City Church to worship there was a young man there that wanted to study and become a Christian. He had been studying with the minister there. Jeffrey studied with him after the morning session and was able to baptize him.
