I learned from her son Greg and daughter Susan that they had played recordings of Diana singing with her, and she was responding to every song.

I asked Greg and Susan what one of her favorite hymns was. They mentioned "In the Garden." When I visited with Kay, I sang this hymn by her bedside, including all three stanzas.

As I sang the final verse, I specifically noticed these words:

"I'd stay in the garden with Him, Though the night around me be falling; But He bids me go; through the voice of woe, His voice to me is calling."

I said, "Kay, His voice is calling you home. It's all right to go and be with the Lord." I prayed with her one last time and then left.

The family reported that moments later, Kay responded to that voice and went home. I will never think of this song the same way again. That chorus says it all:

"And He walks with me, and He talks with me, And He tells me I am His own; And the joy we share as we tarry there, None other has ever known."

The joy that Kay is now experiencing is what this life is all about—that we simply strive to walk with Him in this life right into eternity. The family wanted me to relay that Kay's desire was that there be no funeral arrangements in the event of her passing, so the family has agreed to fulfill her wishes. Since this is the case, I decided to dedicate this article to Kay Carver as a memorial for her life.
