Sea Level

What is the elevation here? I once heard an Alaskan tour guide say this is one of the most frequent questions asked by tourists who arrive in Alaska—by cruise. Getting any lower in elevation would leave one pretty waterlogged. Maybe it is being surrounded by mountains that causes the question, but simply seeing the tops of the mountains does not place us there.

In the same way, seeing God's heights is not the same as standing on them.

This year, as we press on to higher ground, we must realize we stand at sea level in comparison to God's perspective. We may see the heights, but simply seeing them is not the same as standing secure on them (Psalm 18:33).

Sea level is the baseline of human existence. God has placed us in this world for a reason, and we can make choices that take us below sea level, eventually hitting rock bottom in sin. Or we can make decisions to seek higher ground and seek God while He may be found.

David described the place God has made for us to dwell as a world founded on the seas—at sea level. “The earth is the LORD’s and the fullness thereof, the world and those who dwell therein, for he has founded it upon the seas and established it upon the rivers” (Psalm 24:1-2).

The Lord has prepared a world for us to experience and to enjoy. Yet sin has entered this world, making it impossible for us to be content with this world alone. David then asked what man should do in the world God has created when we find ourselves at sea level:

“Who shall ascend the hill of the LORD? And who shall stand in his holy place” (Psalm 24:3)?

To question what is beyond this life is vital. What must we do to be with God?

We should desire to ascend God's holy hill, His holy place.

David went on to define what one must do to leave sea level and climb God's holy hill: “He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to what is false and does not swear deceitfully. He will receive blessing from the LORD and righteousness from the God of his salvation. Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek the face of the God of Jacob” (Psalm 24:4-6).

Sea level is the natural position of all mankind, but it is not the final destination of the faithful. God calls us upward. He calls us away from falsehood, away from complacency, and toward holiness. We must decide whether we will remain content where we are, sink lower into sin, or rise to seek the face of the Lord. The hill is before us. The path has been defined. The only question left is whether we will ascend beyond sea level.
