Only a Holy God

Last Sunday, Jeffrey Howell led the song "Only a Holy God." It is a powerful and encouraging hymn that turns our attention to the true audience of our worship—the one and only holy God. The verses are framed as a series of questions, each building toward the same resounding answer.

Who else commands all the hosts of heaven?
Who else could make every king bow down?
Who else can whisper and darkness tremble?
Only a Holy God.
What other beauty demands such praise?
What other splendor outshines the sun?
What other majesty rules with perfect justice?
Only a Holy God.
What other glory consumes like fire?
What other power can raise the dead?
What other name remains forever undefeated?
Only a Holy God.
Who else could rescue me from my failures?
Who else would offer His only Son?
Who else invites me to call Him Father?
Only a Holy God.
Only my Holy God.

Each question lifts our thoughts higher. The song begins with the vastness of God's rule over heaven and earth, moves through His unmatched beauty and justice, and finally brings us to the personal wonder of salvation. The God who commands the hosts of heaven is the same God who rescues sinners and invites them to call Him Father. The only fitting answer to every question is the same: there is no one like Him.

The chorus makes clear that the song is not merely describing God—it is calling us to worship Him.

"Come and behold Him, the One and the Only.
Cry out, sing holy forever.
A Holy God—come and worship the Holy God."

It is an invitation to pause the noise and distractions of life and behold the greatness of God. Worship begins when we stop looking at ourselves and fix our attention on Him.

Our family has loved this song, especially because it has lingered long after Sunday worship ended. It has been sung while getting the boys ready for school and hummed while dishes were being put away. That is one of the blessings of learning a new song, it wakes up our thinking. Instead of singing from habit, we begin to reflect on the words again. Our minds engage with what our hearts are proclaiming.

And what a privilege it is that God has given His people voices to sing His praise. Every week, Christians lift their voices together in worship. What could bring people to humble themselves in this way, to praise, adore, and submit their hearts before the throne of heaven?
