Food for the Soul

Food has always been the essential foundation of every civilization. As individuals, our need for food is only rivalled by a few other things like our need to breathe, metabolize, etc. As Americans, it is estimated that though we represent 5% of the world's population, we consume approximately 25% of all resources – including food. Our lives and schedules revolve around food, and there is seldom a day that we go without it. And other than overconsumption, there is nothing wrong with food being so central to our lives and existence. It is important and necessary. While there are very few of us who fail to regularly feed our physical bodies, how good are we at regularly feeding our souls?

According to the Bible, not only do we have a physical metabolism, but also a spiritual metabolism. We can grow spiritually (Eph. 4:15) or we can wither spiritually (Lk. 8:6, 13). We can get stronger spiritually (James 5:8) or we can get weaker spiritually (Rom. 4:19). Whether or not we grow and get stronger spiritually is crucially dependent on whether or not we feed our souls spiritual food regularly. God will always do His part to strengthen us and to help us grow (1 Pet. 5:10). But our own choices about our spiritual metabolism will determine whether or not we do grow in God and Christ. Feeding on the Word of God as individuals is crucial to growing and getting stronger spiritually (1 Pet. 2:2). The Word of God needs to dwell in all of us richly (Col. 3:16). This simply can't happen if you only get spoon-fed the Bible once a week.

We have been so blessed this year to have a weekly fellowship meal on Wednesday nights before church. The food and more importantly the fellowship have been so encouraging to everyone, and it has allowed us to get to spend more time together getting close to one another. The encouragement that comes with more fellowship is vital to helping us grow spiritually, and helps prevent us from growing weaker and falling away (Heb. 3:12-13). But what is also more important than the delicious food we have been getting is the fact that coming together on Wednesday gives us another dose of the Word of God that we desperately need to stay alive spiritually (John 6:63). God's Word is food to keep our souls alive. So, if you are physically able to come on Wednesday nights for awesome food, encouraging fellowship, and the spiritual nourishment of the Word, then I would encourage you to not neglect what your soul needs. We need each other and the truth of God's Word. Those needs are met when we are together (Eph. 4:15-16). Let's feed our souls and grow together!
