**Belize Mission History**

Mission Sunday, May 4, 2025

May 1969 – Bro Jerry and Mamie Jenkins and Marv Steffins went to Belize. They established a weekly radio broadcast from which a number of people were enrolled in Bible Correspondence courses (BCC).

June 1969 – The Church sent Luther Salvage to Belize for 1 yr. Several people were baptized, with Bro. A. E. Sheran being the first he baptized and the last was Bro. Melvin Davis, who became the minister at the Belize City Church of Christ.

July 1970 - Bro Herman King, an Elder at Woodlawn and Bro. Jerry Jenkins went to Belize. Bro. Wilber Sheran was baptized and 100 people were enrolled in Bible Correspondence courses.

October 1970 – Bro. Jenkins and Bro. Ernest Mitchell held a meeting showing the Jule Miller film strips and enrolled 189 BCCs. They went to Monkey River in the southernmost part of Belize and preached in 2 schools in the town of about 400 people. Bro. Hugh Frazer was baptized and the Church started meeting every Sunday in the home of the Frazers.

1972 - Bro. Jenkins and Bro Hurd joined Mr. & Mrs. Bever and 19 college students from Oklahoma Christian College arrived in Belize for 21 days and taught the gospel. 19 people was baptized at Bird Isle in Belize City. At this point 80 people had been baptized in Belize and 3 congregations were established.

August 1972 - Bro. Hurd went to Corozal and studied with one of the Gilharry girls and converted most of the family. This family went on to be and still is a very strong influence in the Corozal Church. Bro. Calvin Gilharry passed away just a few months ago.

October 1972 - 13 members from Woodlawn spent a week and joined with students from Oklahoma Christian and taught and baptized 43. 34 lived in Belize City, 1 in Punta Gorda and 8 in Corozal.

June 1973 - The Westmoreland's arrived in Belize and remained until 1975. 116 were baptized, 1200 was enrolled in Bible correspondence courses.

August 1973 - Third campaign with 44 going to Belize. Campaigns were in Punta Gorda, Orange Walk, Corozal and 2 Vacation Bible schools were conducted in Belize City. There were 21 baptized in Belize City, 10 in Orange Walk, 8 in Corozal and 2 in Punta Gorda.

April 1974 - 7 men from Woodlawn went to Belize and spent a week working in Stann Creek, baptizing several and establishing a Church there.

August 1974 - 35 campaigners went for 3 weeks in 4 different cities, Stann Creek, Belmopan, Orange Walk and Punta Gorda. 554 Home Bible studies were conducted.

We have been conducting campaigns in Belize for 55 years. There are congregations throughout the whole country of Belize. For the past 3 years we have conducted a Church Leadership Seminar at Belize City Church of Christ in October where ministers from all the Belize Churches of Christ are invited come for a week of study and fellowship. We currently do campaigns in Corozal, Ladyville and Belize City.

We need families like yours to go to Belize. Gary Cosby
