### The End is Upon Us!

Every time war or global conflict appears on the horizon, so also do the doomsday prophets: "The end is upon us! It's finally happening!" They fling open the book of Revelation and point to various passages that they claim are being fulfilled right before our eyes. They are often not alone in this reaction to war. Many people in general also resort to interpreting global conflict as a sign of the end. But is this the correct mentality? How should Christians respond to major world conflicts and events? No one answers this question better than Jesus Himself:

"When you hear of wars and rumors of wars, do not be frightened; those things must take place; but that is not yet the end. For nation will rise up against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; there will be earthquakes in various places; there will also be famines. These things are merely the beginning of birth pangs." (Mk. 13:7-8)

From the time of Jesus to the present, wars have continued along with human speculation about the end. But as Jesus points out, wars, famines, and earthquakes will happen before the end. And these things are merely the beginning. Jesus tells us when we hear of wars not to be frightened (Mk. 13:7). That should be our first and primary response.

Second, we should remember that no one knows when the end will come. As Jesus also declared, "But of that day or hour no one knows, not even the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but the Father alone." How many people throughout history have proclaimed the day the world will end only for it to come and go? Wasn't it supposed to be in 2012? William Miller, the leader of the movement that led to the establishment of the Seventh Day Adventist Church, predicted that Jesus would return between 1843 and 1844. The year came and went without Christ's return, leading to what has been widely called "The Great Disappointment." Even back in the 1st century, false teachers Hymenaeus and Philetus claimed that Jesus had already come back (2 Tim. 2:16-18)! So we learn this from history and Jesus: Nobody knows when the end will come. He will come back when no one is expecting Him to come (Mat. 24:36-39; 42-44, 50).

Last, we should remember what Scripture tells us to do as the end draws nearer: Always be ready to meet the Lord (Mk. 13:33, 35, 37). Revelation tells us to heed the message that Jesus is coming back and will judge His people according to their deeds (Rev. 1:3; 2:23; 22:7, 12). Peter reminds us that knowing that the end is coming should inspire us to conduct ourselves in holiness and godliness (2 Pet. 3:11-12). As global conflicts do remind us that the end will come, let us always remember that Jesus tells us not to be frightened but to trust Him. Let us remember that no one knows when the end will come and so do not be misled. And let us remember to live our lives ready for the return of the Lord.

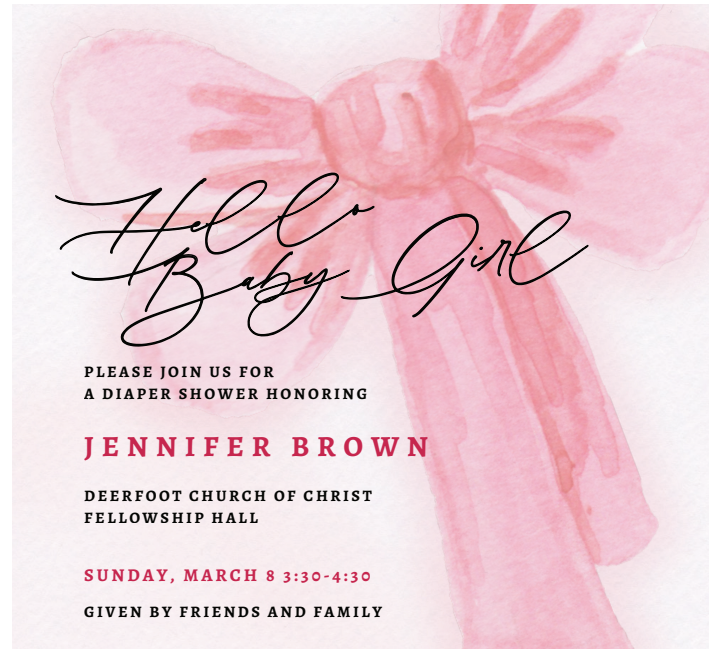
