Because He Lives

“This is the day the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it” (Psalm 118:24).
Today is the Lord’s Day.
But what makes this day worth rejoicing in?
It’s not just that God made “a” day, it’s that God made “this” day possible.

Because He lives.

Peter explains it plainly:

“Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a man attested to you by God with mighty works and wonders and signs that God did through him in your midst, as you yourselves know 23 this Jesus, delivered up according to the definite plan and foreknowledge of God, you crucified and killed by the hands of lawless men. 24 God raised him up, loosing the pangs of death, because it was not possible for him to be held by it.” (Acts 2:22–24).

This changes everything. God raised Jesus on the first day of the week, and because of that, this day will forever belong to Him.

This is the Lord’s Day... because He lives.

And His resurrection doesn’t just mark a moment in history; it gives us two life-altering realities.

First: Because He lives, we have hope beyond death. Death is no longer a final destination; it is a doorway.

“But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.” (Philippians 3:20–21).

Jesus defeated death. And because He lives, we will live also. What time destroys, He will restore. What death claims, He will reclaim.

Second: Because He lives, we have power in this life. Not just future resurrection, present transformation.

“We were buried therefore with him by baptism into death, in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life. For if we have been united with him in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his” (Romans 6:4–5).

Through baptism, we don’t just look forward to resurrection we participate in it.

We rise. We walk. We live renewed.

This is the life the world is searching for and only Christ can give it. And that’s why we rejoice today. Because He lives, I can face tomorrow. Because He lives, all fear is gone. Because I know He holds the future... Life is worth the living just

because He lives.
