**The Last Meal**

What if this was the last time you partook of the Lord's Supper? Your last meal?

Would there be somebody you need to reconcile with? Someone you have been meaning to share the Gospel with? Is there someone who needs to hear from you?

Jesus knew what that last meal was like. He knew what it meant to tie up loose ends.

"... and when he had given thanks, he broke it, and said, 'This is my body, which is for you. Do this in remembrance of me.' In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, saying, 'This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me.' For as often as you eat this bread and drink the cup, you proclaim the Lord's death until he comes" (1 Corinthians 11:24-26).

We partake of a feast that proclaims the Lord's death till He returns. I want you to stop and think about what this means. We proclaim His death till He returns.

This is similar to what Jesus did since His childhood partaking of the Passover. We have 4 recorded feasts where Jesus celebrated the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Three feasts that literally proclaimed the Lord's death, the death of the lamb, till it came in the 4th observance of the Passover.

Paul told the Corinthian church, "For I received from the Lord what I also delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus on the night when he was betrayed took bread." (1 Corinthians 11:23)

Jesus knew this was the last meal.

What did He want for His disciples? "Do this in Remembrance of me." Routine is not remembrance. We as a body will observe the emblems and commune weekly, but are you remembering his body and blood?

He later said that night "I tell you I will not drink again of this fruit of the vine until that day when I drink it new with you in my Father's kingdom" (Matthew 26:29).

One day we will all drink the cup new with Jesus in our Father's Kingdom. It sums up a purpose for all of us. This world is full of stressors and things that we will never be able to take with us. But there is a feast waiting for all of us.

So today proclaim the Lord's death till He comes as if this is

The last meal... because one day, it will give way to the first meal with Him in His Kingdom.
