**Mother's Day**

I remember it was Mother's Day in 2009 when I walked into our kitchen and saw Mary standing there. She turned to me with one of the biggest smiles I had ever seen and said, "Happy Father's Day."

Finding out Mary was a mother on Mother's Day was a joy I still can't fully put into words. At first, I remember thinking, "We got a bonus Mother's Day before she officially became a mother." But over time, I've come to believe that thought wasn't quite right. In a very real sense, a woman begins her journey of motherhood at conception. From that moment, a child begins to develop within her. Her body nourishes and sustains that life in ways that are nothing short of remarkable. That tiny heartbeat begins as early as day 22 or 23. Fingernails form around week 12, and eyelashes by week 22. As her baby is forming, so is her role, one marked by sacrifice, care, and selflessness.

Mothers give of their very lives to bring life into the world. And while that journey builds over time, there is a moment when it all comes together: The first time a mother holds her child. That face-to-face embrace is something unlike anything else in this world. And yet, it points to a relationship even greater.

There is a parable of sorts attributed to Dr. Wayne Dyer that explains this perfectly.

"In a mother's womb, two babies were conceived. As weeks passed and the twins developed, their awareness grew. They laughed for joy, excited to be alive, exploring their cozy, dark world. As they grew, one twin feared the inevitable end of their world, while the other held onto hope for life after birth, arguing there must be more to existence. The skeptic dismissed the idea of a life with light, movement, or nourishment outside the umbilical cord.

While the first twin denied the existence of a "Mother" due to lack of evidence, the second believed that by listening in the silence, one could perceive her loving presence.

Ultimately, the twins were born into a new, larger world, realizing the womb was merely a temporary preparation, and they were welcomed by the mother they had debated."

The world questions God, and even questions the sanctity of motherhood. May we all rejoice that we survived the womb. May we rejoice that our mothers brought us into this world and that we know we will leave it one day to meet our Father face to face.

So today, may we rejoice.

Rejoice that we were given life. Rejoice in the mothers who carried, nurtured, and loved us.

And rejoice in the hope of what is still to come.
