Lay it to Heart

Tomorrow is Memorial Day. So often, the holidays that receive the greatest attention are the ones centered around giving and receiving gifts. We see this in different ways at Christmas, Easter, and even Halloween.

Memorial Day is different. We do not receive instant gratification from remembering this day, especially when it is often overshadowed by mattress sales and outdoor grill promotions.

Yet it is important to pause and lay this holiday to heart. When we stop and reflect on the meaning of Memorial Day, we recognize that we all have received a gift. It is a holiday that reminds us why we are able to enjoy all the other holidays, because we have freedom. It was the deathbeds of countless men and women that made it possible to get that bed at a discount.

Memorial Day was originally established on May 30, 1868, under the name Decoration Day. It began as a time to place flowers on the graves of fallen Union and Confederate soldiers from the War Between the States.

Just as a funeral is not ultimately for the dead but for the living, Memorial Day is not for the benefit of those who have passed on, but for us who remain. We did not have to pay the ultimate price for our freedom. Another husband paid that price so I could hold my wife. Another mother gave her life so you could raise your children. Another son died so yours could graduate with honors.

Solomon, in his wisdom, recognized what remembrance of the dead does for the living: "A good name is better than precious ointment, and the day of death than the day of birth. It is better to go to the house of mourning than to go to the house of feasting, for this is the end of all mankind, and the living will lay it to heart" (Ecclesiastes 7:1-2).

Think of every good name written on memorials across this country since Memorial Day's beginning: the Spanish-American War (1898), World War I (1917-1918), World War II (1941-1945), the Korean War (1950-1953), the Vietnam War (1955-1975), the Gulf War and Operation Desert Storm (1990-1991), the War in Afghanistan (2001-2021), the Iraq War (2003-2011), and the continuing Global War on Terror.

When you hear news of soldiers who have died, stop and honor them. Pray for their families. Thank God for the freedoms you enjoy. Do not let the day pass without allowing the weight of that sacrifice to touch you.

Lay it to heart.
