To Err is Human?

“To err is human, to forgive is divine.” While this famous quote from Alexander Pope may be rather simplistic, it undeniably rings true on a fundamental level. Every day as humans, we err. Morally or practically, we make mistakes more often than we would care to admit. The Bible affirms over and over again, the reality of human error. All have sinned (Rom. 3:23). Every righteous person has sinned (Ecc. 7:20). There is no person who does not sin (1 Kings 8:46). Anyone who claims to be without sin makes God out to be a liar (1 John 1:10). The only exception of course was Jesus Himself (Heb. 4:15). Simply put, no human is without error or sin. For these reasons, this famous quote appears relatively uncontroversial. However, such a quote may seem to suggest that the very fact of being a human is to inevitably fall into sin and error. Is this true? Is the simple state of being a human a guarantee that sin and error will occur? Some think that sin is predetermined and therefore inevitable. Others think that while sin is not predetermined, all people have and will choose to sin because of humanity's fallen nature. Generally, these are the two main views. What does the Bible tell us? Ever since the fall, did it become inevitable for humanity to give into sin?

Genesis 4 reveals the truth about humanity's post-fall condition towards sin. In the account of Cain and Abel, we find that Cain begins to harbor ill-feelings towards his brother because God favored his brother's sacrifice over his own. Seeing the danger of Cain's anger and grudge, God warned Cain of what his anger and hatred can lead to. He said the following: "...sin is crouching at the door; and its desire is for you, but you must master it" (Gen. 4:7). Notice, God didn't say, "Well, it's inevitable that you're going to sin. You're corrupted and fallen, and there's no way for you not to sin." Nor did God say, "Because of your fallen nature, your will is not strong enough to fight against sin." On the contrary, God told Cain, "You must master it (sin)." Would God command Cain to do something that he was incapable of doing? Did God mean what He said? It's a ridiculous notion to say that God would require anyone to do something that the person was incapable of.

God made mankind upright (Ecc. 7:29) and in His image (Gen. 1:26-28). The image of God in which man was made was not altered or changed by sin according to the Bible (Gen. 9:6). The truth is, to be upright and in the likeness of God is to be human. This is our true identity and design. Always has been. Whether we fulfill it or not is our choice and every person's choice. So let us never forget, to truly be human is to be godly. This is our design and intent. Let us strive to always fulfill it and overcome sin.
