Father of the Fatherless

“Father of the fatherless and protector of widows is God in his holy habitation” (Psalm 68:5).

I have a close friend who lost his father when he was young. He is the one who first introduced this passage to me. God became the only father he truly knew and the protector of his mother.

Today is Father’s Day.

For many, the role of father has been filled by a coach, a teacher, or a grandfather. This is not a perfect world where every man embraces the responsibility of fatherhood. Yet every child needs a father. James wrote about what makes religion pure and undefiled before God: “Religion that is pure and undefiled before God the Father is this: to visit orphans and widows in their affliction, and to keep oneself unstained from the world” (James 1:27).

When Mary and I were first married, our ministry focused on youth. Every one of the kids in our youth group had parents who were actively involved in their lives. Their fathers participated in countless ways and helped make ministry possible.

That was the case until I met Lupe. Lupe was eight years old when he first walked across the railroad tracks to our side of town so he could play on our church playground. I noticed him playing there one day and went outside to introduce myself. Vacation Bible School was coming up, so I invited him to attend. After the first night, Lupe approached me, grabbed the collar of my shirt, pulled me down to his level, and said, “I want you to come pick me up every time the doors are open!” So, I did. Before long, Lupe was constantly walking to our house next to the playground. He did his homework there. I taught him how to play catch and helped get him involved in Little League. In many ways, Mary and I tried to provide for Lupe the same kind of care and support our parents had provided for us.

You see, Lupe’s father was in prison. His mother was in and out of jail. His older brothers were the only reason Child Protective Services had not placed him in foster care. Lupe eventually became a Christian, and the church became his home. He reminded us that everyone deserves a chance and that everyone needs a Heavenly Father. Sometimes God chooses to work through ordinary people to demonstrate His love as the Father of the fatherless.
