No Disrespect

Whenever you hear someone say, “no disrespect,” what sometimes follows is ironically disrespectful. It goes without saying that people are offended when disrespected and prefer to be held in honor and respect. But while respect is highly sought after, it’s not often given. What is the reason for this? It’s largely because people do not view respecting others as an obligation but instead view respect as something that others must earn. “You gotta earn my respect!” Respect is usually a response as opposed to a default disposition toward others. But what should our attitude towards respecting others be? Should we only give it to those who earn it, or should it be freely given to all?

While it may be natural human inclination to reserve respect and honor for those who earn it, God’s Word reveals that giving respect and honor to all people is a requirement. As it says in 1 Pet. 2:17, “Honor all people...” This command leaves little room for exceptions or picking and choosing who to honor. This broad command may be difficult for many to swallow. After all, it is more than obvious that not everyone is in fact honorable. But God’s command to honor all people is clearly not based on whether people deserve honor or not. That Christians must show honor and respect even to those who are not honorable is made evident throughout the New Testament. Those who are in authority must be considered worthy of honor even if they are unreasonable (1 Pet. 2:17-18), hypocritical (Mat. 23:2-3), and do not abide by the law (Acts 23:3-5). We should seek to be pleasing to all people (1 Cor. 10:33) and respect what is right in the sight of all people (Rom. 12:17b). These verses of course do not refer to pleasing people and respecting what people respect to the point of compromising the gospel (Gal. 1:10). This type of people pleasing and respect is not permitted by God. But honoring and respecting others in a godly way for the purpose of winning people over to the Gospel is what Christians are called to do (1 Cor. 9:19-23).

Showing honor and respect to all people can certainly be crucial to leading them to salvation, but why else should we indiscriminately show honor and respect to all? We should show respect and honor to all because we too were once lost in sin (Tit. 3:2-3). Also, we are all made in the image of God and should therefore show mutual respect to all (James 3:9). And we must recognize that there is a crucial difference between showing to all people for these reasons versus respecting the things they do. According to Jesus, you can show respect to a person without approving of or giving praise to their sinful behavior (Mat. 23:2-3). So let us strive to show honor and respect to all as an example to the world, and as lights of the Gospel in a world of disrespect.

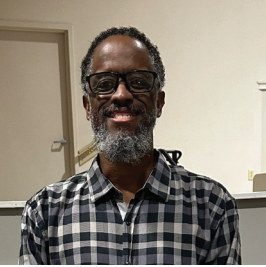
