Level Up

I was born the year the first Nintendo hit the market in 1985. Since New Zealand was a good ten years behind America, we had an Atari (I remember it being the rare white console). Video games have come a long way in today's world. Video games have become less about gaming and more immersive virtual experiences for many people.

Entire careers have been built around video games, and some universities now offer full-ride scholarships to talented gamers and esports competitors. My cousin just received a scholarship to attend Freed-Hardeman University for esports, and it is helping pay for his degree. For years, the military has utilized gamers for drone navigation and remote weapons systems. I remember hearing that the controls for one remote weapons system were modeled after PlayStation controllers since the soldiers were already familiar with them.

Our VBS theme this year utilizes video games to make applications to the Scriptures. We will be discussing Daniel, David and Goliath, Esther, Joshua, and the Great Commission. I am looking forward to hearing from our teachers about what it takes to "Level Up" in our Christian walk.

In a video game, to "level up" means to gain experience points (XP), allowing the player to become stronger, wiser, and often more capable than when they first began. Gamers progress through challenges and strive to reach expert-level achievements. This concept connects well to the Christian walk. We all need to "Level Up" in our faith.

God is the Designer of all things. He has supplied us with the tools necessary to level up and achieve incredible heights. Peter explains, in other words, that we need to level up our faith. He describes how God has given us the equipment necessary to do so: "His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence, by which he has granted to us his precious and very great promises, so that through them you may become partakers of the divine nature, having escaped from the corruption that is in the world because of sinful desire. For this very reason, make every effort to supplement your faith with virtue, and virtue with knowledge, and knowledge with self-control, and self-control with steadfastness, and steadfastness with godliness, and godliness with brotherly affection, and brotherly affection with love. For if these qualities are yours and are increasing, they keep you from being ineffective or unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ" (2 Peter 1:3-8).

When we continue to grow in our faith, we will defeat the desires of the flesh and allow God's Word to transform our lives. We will level up.
