Time

A great deal has taken place over the last several weeks. It is hard to believe that VBS is already behind us and that Camp Maywood 2026 has also come and gone. Our Back-to-School Bash is quickly approaching on July 31. Summer will be gone before we know it. Time has a way of slipping through our fingers.

Solomon had much to say about time: "For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven: a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted" (Ecclesiastes 3:1-2).

Solomon goes on to list twenty-four more activities that each have their appointed time, one for every hour of the day. He then summarizes the purpose of time and where our focus should be as we deal with this precious commodity:

"What gain has the worker from his toil? I have seen the business that God has given to the children of man to be busy with. He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also, he has put eternity into man's heart, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end" (Ecclesiastes 3:9-11).

Eternity is in our hearts, but our hearts themselves are not eternal. The wise writer reminds us of this truth first and foremost. There is a time when our hearts first begin to beat, and there is a time when they beat their last.

So, what good is eternity being placed within something so temporary? The God who placed eternity in our hearts has also told us why we are here and how our time should be spent if we are to find true purpose and fulfillment.

"Hear, O Israel: The LORD our God, the LORD is one. You shall love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart" (Deuteronomy 6:4-6).

When God's words are on our hearts, and in our actions, they fulfill the eternity that He has placed within us. Jesus expressed this truth beautifully:

"Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied" (Matthew 5:6).

We will find true satisfaction only in what is eternal. If our contentment is rooted solely in the fleeting moments of this life, in the commodity that continually slips through our fingers called time, we will always be left wanting.
