The Deception of Sin

To no one's surprise, we know that advertisements are sometimes misleading. Whether it's a new product, drug, or investment opportunity, advertisements often present an incomplete picture or sometimes a completely distorted picture. The side effects of drugs are hidden and diminished. Defective products are sometimes advertised as efficient and simple. It makes you wonder, what would honest advertising look like? "Purchase now, and hours of frustration can be yours! After learning how defective our product is, you will send it back to us guaranteed! But don't expect a refund!" Or maybe, "We just want your money, and we are willing to say anything to get it – as long as it doesn't get us into legal trouble!" Not all products are worthless. Not all advertising is deceptive. But anyone who is selling a bad product is not going to be able to sell it effectively through honesty. Only deception can sell a bad product effectively.

And so this is true of sin. The pleasure that sin affords is its main selling point, while its negative consequences are diminished or excluded. Who would buy sin if it was sold with absolute honesty? "I have this fantastic product! If you purchase it, it will tear your family in two, you'll lose half of your possessions, you'll be disdained by those who know you, you'll be slowly consumed by guilt, and in the end you'll be destroyed forever! Will that be cash or card?" No one would purchase this product! And yet, every single year this product is bought in bulk by humanity. It's called adultery. And those who are tempted by it often only consider its immediate and temporary pleasure. God's Word, however, always tells the full story about this sin (Prov. 5:3-14; 23:27-28). "I've got another great product! How would you like to multiply your sorrows, create contentions, experience severe nausea, kill your productivity, and be reduced to poverty?" Again, who's buying this?! And yet, I just described a wildly popular product. This is the product of drunkenness. Unlike the world, the Bible tells us what it really results in (Prov. 23:21, 29-35). "How would you like to have everything taken away from you and your future ruined?" This is the product of stealing (Prov. 1:11-19). "How would you like to lose what you gain and pursue death?" This is the product of a life of lying (Prov. 21:6).

Sin is deceitful (Heb. 3:13). It's so deceitful that even though its consequences are not a secret, many chose not to consider them or willful remain ignorant of them. But if people judge sin by what it produces, they will reject as readily as they would a cheap or defective product. "Why would I want something that leaves me with nothing but pain and loss?" Sin gives temporary and deceptive products, but righteousness produces an eternal reward (Prov. 11:18). Sin only offers passing pleasure (Heb. 11:25), but in the end it produces eternal death (Rom. 6:19-21). Try selling eternal condemnation as a desirable product. So let us always remember how stupid and undesirable sin is. Let us judge sin by what it produces, and help the world to see through the deceitfulness of sin.
